The percentage of students in the national norms group for this grade, subject, and test administration season that this student's score equaled or exceeded.


Fall to Fall Growth


An indicator of how much the student's score increased since the previous Fall, compared to other students with similar scores in the same grade and season.






Subscores - Smarter Balanced Assessment Standards Alignment



Novice, Developing, Proficient and Advanced show the RIT ranges aligned to Smarter Balanced Assessment standards for the student's grade and season.


